Dear Families:

The Wyoming Valley West School District will discontinue asynchronous (recorded) instruction and packets, and instead, implement an in-person and synchronous (live) platform for all general and special education students. This new instructional platform is designed to assist all students in our District with a smooth transition back to the full-time, brick-and-mortar setting when the health and safety concerns associated with COVID-19 have been alleviated. Please note, at any time, if you have any questions/concerns moving forward, please contact your child's case manager to schedule an IEP meeting.

Students receiving special education supports and related services virtually will receive services from the same teacher/related service provider who would work with the student if he/she were participating in in-person instruction. Delivery methodology will be synchronous (live) instruction.

Regarding the District's use of synchronous learning and tele-therapy, please note the following privacy guidelines:

- Unauthorized recordings which include photos of instructional materials, photos, and/or videos posted to social media or online, are strictly prohibited by all parties including Wyoming Valley West School District.
- The parent/guardian shall make every effort to ensure that no one other than the student scheduled to participate can see or hear the live virtual session. Ear buds and/or head sets are suggested.
- A parent/guardian or other designated adult must be present and visible in an individual virtual session to enable a student to participate.
- When participating in a video session, please be mindful of the educational environment and eliminate distractions that may divert the students' attention away from learning.
