

Synchronous Learning Expectations

Student Edition

What is synchronous instruction?

Synchronous instruction means instruction in “real-time” conducted via Google Meets. Students will log into Google Meets for each class period during the time the class is taking place in person. The student’s teacher will be teaching a class in person and the students who are at home simultaneously.

Method of Instruction (options):

1. Google Classroom - 5 days of synchronous instruction
2. Hybrid - 2 days of in person instruction, 3 days of synchronous instruction

**Please make sure your homeroom teacher has your most up to date method of instruction.

Attendance:

You will need to log into each class period at the designated time. Failure to log in will result in an absence for that period. Students signing in late (3 minutes) will be marked tardy for that class period.
