2020-2021 LEARNING OPTIONS

PARENT CHOICE:

WVW HYBRID LEARNING, WVW GOOGLE CLASSROOM REMOTE LEARNING, or WVW CYBER SCHOOL

Choice must be made for a minimum of 1 marking period.



• WVW HYBRID LEARNING: Student is registered as a Wyoming Valley West student and scheduled for specific classes that meet at specific times in specific buildings during the school day. This mode involves a combination of virtual and in-person instruction. Students are assigned to groups who are scheduled to attend class in person on certain days and to participate in virtual (online) Google Classroom instruction delivered by the scheduled teachers on other days. The student has the opportunity to interact with other students and teachers during the school day when physically present and with the teacher on a regular basis during the virtual instruction days. (Group A includes students with last names A-K, Group B includes students with last names L-Z.) Weekly schedule: Group A in building on Monday and Tuesday, Group B in building on Thursday and Friday. On Wednesday, all students are on Virtual Learning. Student participation is required and graded.

• WVW GOOGLE CLASSROOM REMOTE LEARNING: Student is registered as a Wyoming Valley West student and scheduled for specific classes in the WVW course of planned instruction. This mode involves virtual instruction through the Google Classroom platform, delivered on a daily basis. All students enrolled in WVW GC Remote Learning participate in virtual (online) instruction delivered by the scheduled teachers each day. Students access the materials and activities independently, but progress through the curriculum at the daily pace of the specific classroom. Students have the opportunity to interact with teachers on a regular basis. Honors and Advanced Placement classes are offered in this mode. Student participation is required and graded.

• WVW CYBER SCHOOL: Student is registered as a Wyoming Valley West student and scheduled for specific classes aligned to the WVW curriculum K-12. The program of study is delivered through Edgenuity, a technology platform, facilitated and monitored by WVW teachers in the CyberSchool who are certified in each content area. The student has the opportunity to progress through the curriculum at his/her own pace and to interact with WVW teachers. Student participation is required and graded.
