WVW Cyber Education

Does your child work well independently? Does he/she excel at his/her own pace and not on a set schedule?

Work follows a schedule like normal school. Monday's work needs to be done on Monday, etc. As long as all work is done by the end of the semester, the student can work however and whenever he/she likes. For example, he/she can complete the entire Math course first and then move on to another subject area.

Does your child want Honors or AP classes?

Offers Honors and AP classes with regularly scheduled teacher

NO Honors or AP option

Does your student really struggle with attendance issues, maintaining a schedule, or assignments start to pile up?

Does the student have a part-time job?

Assignments will be given daily and the grade will suffer if they aren't completed on time.

Updates will be given that the student is falling behind, but grade won't suffer as long as the course is completed by the end of the marking period.

Will you be comfortable sending your child back to school before there is a vaccine?

Google Classroom will allow students to have a seamless transition back to the regular school day, including the same schedule and teachers. This option also makes sense if your student would struggle with independent learning. WVW Cyber is especially effective for students who are self-motivated and want to learn but not necessarily to participate in the daily activities of the school setting. Most WVW Cyber students are in it long-term, not as a temporary option.

Are you just hoping for as regular a year as possible?

This is the traditional option that allows students to maintain a "normal" schedule of classes with the same teachers they would have had in a "normal" school year.

If you were attracted to cyber education prior to the pandemic, consider WVW Cyber. It's similar to Agora/PA Cyber but run by WVW teachers with video lectures and other cyber instruction, tests graded immediately, daily progress updates, and retests/teacher support if a student is struggling.
